

License and Terms of Use of NOX

License AGPL-3.0

The NOX system is currently distributed under the GNU Affero General Public License, Version 3.0 (AGPL-3.0), with an additional condition from NOX regarding the right to change the license.

The GNU Affero General Public License, Version 3.0, is a free license that grants users the right to use, study, modify, and distribute the software. The license requires that all modified versions or derivative works must also be distributed under the terms of AGPL-3.0, including the source code and the ability to freely obtain it. Unlike the GPL, the AGPL extends these requirements to the use of the program over a network: if the software runs on a server and provides remote access to users, they must have the ability to obtain the source code. The purpose of the license is to protect users' freedom and prevent restrictions on access to the code.

Additional Conditions of NOX

NOX reserves the right to change the license of the project in the future. Any changes in licensing must not contradict the core principles of the system, including decentralization, privacy protection, and minimization of data collection.

Privacy Policy of NOX

NOX does not collect or store any personal user data. The system does not use cookies, identifiers, or logs that could be used to track activities. All data transmission is encrypted, with no possibility of interception or analysis by third parties.
